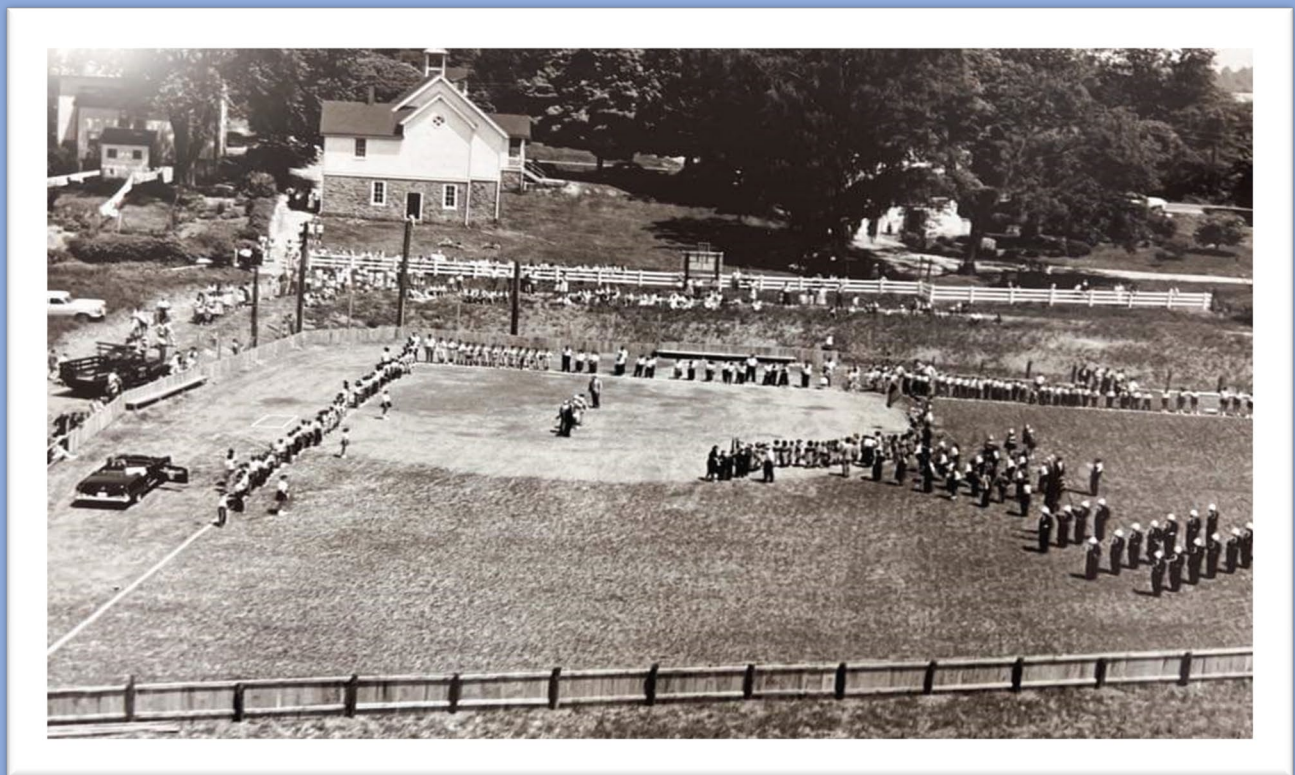




Opening Day for the **Rising Sun Little League** is

## **WHY ARE WATER MAINS FLUSHED?**

Water main flushing is generally completed twice a year to test the hydrants for efficient water flow and pressure. Water main flushing also allows the Town to remove any sediment from the water lines.

## **WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING THIS PERIOD?**

During water main flushing, residents may experience temporary changes in water pressure or clarity.

Do NOT wash white or light-colored laundry during the flushing operations.

Wash a load of dark colored clothes first. If your laundry becomes stained, do not dry it. Wash it again with clean water and detergent, using a rust removing agent.

If water is discolored, run cold & hot water faucets until water is clear.

Check faucet screens for trapped particles.

## **Safety Guidelines**

**Location: Public Works Garage, 10 Dairy Street, Rising Sun, MD**

**Time: 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon First come, first serve!**

**This dumpster day event will only accept the following items: Household waste, metal goods, and most large, bulky items. Mattresses and Box Springs must be covered to be accepted.**

**Items not accepted: TVs and other electronics, tires, yard waste, or hazardous waste.**

**\*On-site Public Works staff reserves the right to refuse materials.**

Items not accepted can be taken to the Cecil County Central Landfill at  
758 E. Old Philadelphia Rd., Elkton, MD 21921,  
Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. (prices vary)

The "Residential Dumpster Day" will not accept any items from commercial or private haulers, contractors, or landlord/rental unit clean-outs.

Larger vehicles limited to pick-up trucks, passenger vans, or trailers with a max length of 8 ft.

**Upon arriving, remain in your vehicle.**

**Have your proof of Town residency available (ex. driver's license, utility bill, tax or water bill).**

**Residents must unload their own material; Public Works employees will only be available to operate the equipment, not to physically assist anyone.**

# Yard Waste Instructions

**It's that time of year!**

**ITEMS COLLECTED:**

Leaves, Weeds, Brush,  
Grass Clippings and Tree Branches  
No bigger than 3" inches in  
diameter.



**PROHIBITED ITEMS:** Tree limbs in excess of 3" inches diameter or 4 feet long; tree trunks, limbs or other items resulting from a tree removal or work performed by a tree trimmer, arborist, or landscaper.



**REQUIRED CONTAINERS:** Yard Waste can be placed in approved PAPER YARD WASTE BAGS and or a container that can be emptied, such as a trash can, not to exceed 40 lbs. in weight. Branches are permitted but shall not be larger than 3" inches in diameter or 4 feet in length. Branches shall be bundled together and tied tightly, not to exceed 40 lbs. in weight.

**Best of Spring and Summer to everyone!** Remember your Public Works Team as you begin disposing of yard waste materials.

# Swimming Pool Fills



Credits for filling Swimming Pools are limited to 1 per customer in a 12-month consecutive month period (1 per season).

Water consumption is still billed; however, you may qualify for a sewer credit. Must have used a minimum of 1,000 gallons or more of water to be considered for the sewer credit.

## How it works .....

- Complete & Return "Pool Fill Sewer Credit Application."
- Call Town Hall **BEFORE** you start to fill your pool. Leave a voicemail, especially if starting on a weekend, including your name and street address.
- Then call Town Hall when you **FINISH** filling your pool.
- The sewer credit will then be applied to your next utility bill.

\*The sewer credit is based on your previous month's average daily use and calculated on the day(s) the water was used to fill the pool.

## Pool Fill Sewer Credit Application

Sewer Credits may be applied to the monthly utility bill when 1,000 gallons or more of water are used to fill a pool at the billing address. This application must be completed by the homeowner and returned to Town Hall before starting to fill the pool.
